

• On campus employment does not have to be related to a student's degree.

- F-2 students/dependents cannot work on or off campus.
- J-2 students/dependents must apply for an Employment Authorization Document from USCIS to obtain on-campus or off campus employment authorization.
- If you do not have an SSN number and get an on-campus job, F-1 and J-1 students will need to complete our SSN Verification form. This form is only for on-campus employment.

Off-Campus Employment

- Both F-1 and J-1 students must have prior approval and authorization in order to work off campus.
- Working off campus without authorization carries serious immigration consequences.
- Having a social security number does not mean that you have approval to work off campus. F-1 and J-1 students must meet the eligibility requirements and receive prior approval and written authorization for off-campus work/training.
- In the case of CPT for F-1 students and Academic Training for J-1 students, the training must be directly related to your degree and integral to your curriculum. Enrollment in an internship course is required.

U.S. HEALTHCARE



Healthcare Reminder:

In the U.S., if you need medical care, there are three general options: the doctor's office, urgent care, and the emergency room. For most routine medical care, such as an appointment for a check-up with a doctor, you should go to a doctor's office. If you have UCSHIP (USHIP/GSHIP) insurance, you can visit <u>Student Health Services</u> located on campus. They can help with many types of routine healthcare, such as a yearly check-up, women's health, and laboratory tests, and will provide referrals if needed to other resources. Student Health Services also

offers Telehealth (virtual) appointments.

Many doctor's offices are open from 8am-5pm, Monday-Friday. If you need medical care outside of these hours, you may need to visit an urgent care. The emergency room should only be used for true medical emergencies, as it can be expensive with limited coverage by insurance. 
